St James Annual Fellowship Meal

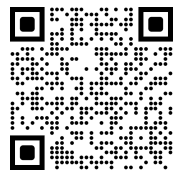

This year I am recommending something a little more technological. It will require loading an app on your smart phone or tablet. This is a free app without advertisements. Use the following steps to get started:

1. Scan the QR Code above to load the app on your device.
2. Once loaded and set-up, select "Plans".
3. Under "Year-Long Bible Plans," select "BibleProject / One Story That Leads to Jesus."
4. Select "Start Plan".

That's it. The plan includes daily readings and devotionals, as well as well as over 150 animated videos to bring the biblical books and themes to life that reveal the Bible as one unified story that leads to Jesus. I hope you will join me this year as we read through the Scriptures and grow ever closer to our Lord and Savior.
